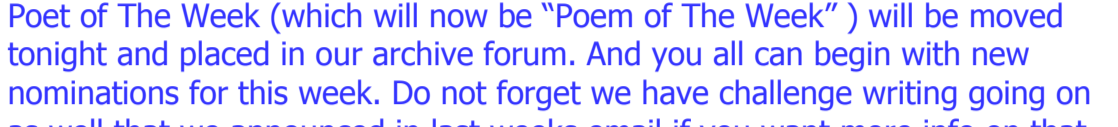

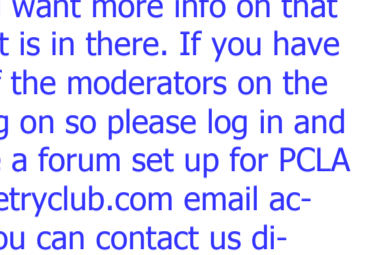
5 Day Poetry Competition! From "Nightshades" (Jeff)
